The Belgian Centre for Pharmacotherapeutic Information (CBIP-BCFI) is a not-profit-making association founded in 1971 and approved by Royal Decree to provide medico-pharmaceutical information about medicinal products. The Board of Directors is composed of university medical faculties, scientific associations of physicians and pharmacists and a representative of the Federal Agency for Medicines and Health Products. The CBIP-BCFI staff consists of 31 people (22 FTE).

CBIP-BCFI provides independent and objective evidence-based information on medicinal products. Over the years, the *Commented Repertory of Medicinal products for Human Use*, the *VetCompendium* and the *Folia* have become essential information tools in the practice of healthcare professionals. CBIP-BCFI is committed to further optimize and digitalize these products to meet the needs of healthcare professionals. The e-learning modules (free and accredited) developed since 2020 are a good example of this and are very successful.
